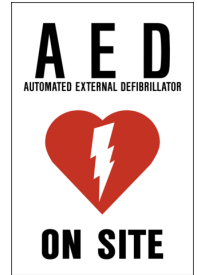

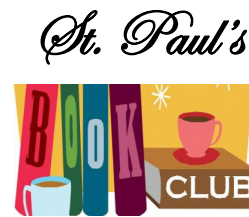
The PRAYER SHAWL MINISTRY APPRECIATES YOUR HELP.

We will gladly assist anyone wanting to try their hand at knitting or crocheting.

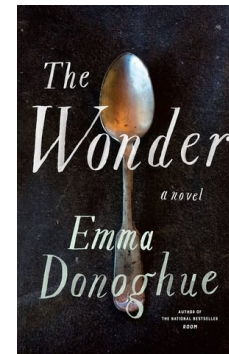
